






Locking the Device to OnTime

Introduction

The biometric devices should be locked to OnTime. When they are locked, even when pressing the home button, it will stay on OnTime.



The device will be delivered with this setting active, however, once a super admin has entered mobile mode, this setting will need to be reactivated. This can be done through a few different ways, depending on whether the default home app has been changed and which device you have.



Step 1 – has the default home app changed?

- If the default home app hasn't changed, it can quickly be relocked back to OnTime
- Press the home button (circled in the previous screenshots, to show them swipe the screen from the right edge to the left, or from the bottom edge upwards)
 - o If the screen flips or shows an icon and stays on OnTime, it is locked and you don't need to do anything else.
 - If a "Select a Home app" menu pops up, select OnTime and then press "Always"



- Once you've pressed always, it will be locked. Press the home screen again to make sure.
- o If you are not prompted to press "Always", follow the same step again and it will ask you will be prompted to press "Always".
- If you press the home screen and it goes straight to the android screen, the home app will need to be reset.
- You'll need to follow the process depending on which Smart Hub you have.




To reset the default home app as OnTime, follow these steps.

• If you don't see the settings app, swipe down from the top edge twice and press the white cog icon in the top right corner






• Press the home button to take you back to OnTime.






Click on apps and notifications



• Click on advanced.








• Click on default apps.



• Click on Home app.



• OnTime will open and the system will have locked it. Press the home button to make sure it has locked.






SmartHub 6 & 7


• The OnTime app will now open and it will be locked. Press the home button to make sure it is locked.






• Press and hold the OnTime app to bring up the "App info" option and press that



• Scroll down to the "Home App" option


